Code Enforcement has introduced “Working in Your Area” neighborhood signs to motivate residents to proactively address potential problems on their property before being issued a citation. These reminders address most common code violations such as high grass and weeds, parking on the grass, outside storage, and removal of trash and debris. Code inspectors place the signs in neighborhoods in which they are working, and they are rotated to other areas as needed.
