

Neighborhoods Receive Grant Funds for Programs

The City of Irving has awarded 13 neighborhood and homeowner associations with \$17,237 in funding for organization projects through the Community Partnership Fund grants.

Administered by the Corporate Communications Department, the grant funds are used to provide seed money to assist organized neighborhoods with their projects. The matching grants allow associations to leverage the organization's existing capital and/or the time and talents of their members with grant funds received from the city in an effort to improve their communities. The money can be used for beautification efforts, communication initiatives and neighborhood events.

Associations receiving funding through this year's Community Partnership Fund are Arts District, Barrington Court, Barton Estates, Cardinal Village, Grauwylers Heights, Hackberry Creek, Irving Hospital District, Mandalay Place, MacArthur Commons, Meadow Lark, Sherwood Forest, Stone Hill and University Hills.
