It's spring cleaning time! Join the thousands of folks that will be out on April 4 picking up litter. The Don't Mess with Texas Trash-Off is an annual event that encourages Texans across the state to join forces to clean up Texas roadsides. An estimated 827 million pieces of litter will collect on our highways this year alone, which means we need your help more than ever.

Volunteers throughout the state remove litter from roadsides, city parks, neighborhoods, and waterways during this annual event. The Don't Mess with Texas Trash-Off is the single largest one day cleanup event in the state and serves as Texas' signature event for the Great American Cleanup, the nation's largest community improvement program. The Trash-Off is part of TXDOT's litter prevention program, which includes Don't Mess with Texas, Adopt-a-Highway, and a grassroots partnership with Keep Texas Beautiful. In 2008, more than 57,000 volunteers picked up five million pounds of litter to help keep our state beautiful.

Your participation sends a message to Texans everywhere that the smallest efforts really do make the biggest difference. Take pride in the fact that you were part of making our great state beautiful! Join in on this event and help make a difference!
