

City of Irving Irrigation Policy and Procedure

Beginning January 1, 2009 the installation of an irrigation system will require a licensed irrigator, licensed engineer, licensed plumbing contractor, or registered landscape architect to design the system.

Exemption:

The home owner may install their own irrigation system without a set of plans. Contractor's with the approved State license will need irrigation plans.

- The new permit fee will be \$100.00 for residential and \$150.00 for commercial.
- The licensed Irrigator will register as a contractor \$120.00 annually
- Pay for the irrigation permit (plans not required at this time)
- Call (972-721-2371) and make an appointment to meet the inspector
- Have the backflow test report and irrigation plans for the inspector
- The plans will be reviewed on site.
- You may cover up after installation leaving a couple of places open to inspect for depth, purple primer, wye strainer, and approved underground wiring.
- Each station will be ran to ensure compliance with the City of Irving Irrigation ordinance
- The backflow assembly must be tested upon installation and after any repairs. The backflow assembly tester must register with Water Utilities @ 333 Valley View Lane in Irving. A current copy of the testers BPAT license and Gauge accuracy report, along with the signed original City of Irving tester registration form, (including a signed tester affidavit) must be submitted.
