AN EASTER EGG-STRAVAGANZA!

(IRVING, TX) - Thousands of toy and candy-filled eggs, a petting zoo and other activities are planned for the Citywide Egg Hunt. Everyone is invited, 9:30 to 11:30 a.m., April 8 at Heritage Park, 217 Main Street. Make sure you pack a camera, we'll have a bunny there too. You'll definitely want to get a picture.

Start times for the egg hunt are staggered according to children's ages:

- Children 3-4 years of age start hunting at 10 a.m.
- Children 5-6 years old will start at 10:20 a.m.
- Children 7-8 years old will start at 10:40 a.m.
- Kids 9-10 will start at 11 a.m.

The city asks participants to arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the listed egg hunt time for your child's age group, as all hunts will start on time. Adults are not permitted to assist children in the egg hunts, and are encouraged to watch and enjoy from the viewing areas alongside the egg hunt field.

Even the youngest egg hunters can take part. Children ages 1-2, who are able to walk independently, can take part in the Egg Stroll. Up to two adults can accompany the children. The Egg Stroll is scheduled to begin at 10 a.m. in a specially designated area.

Families will even have the chance to meet the Easter Bunny. Those families with cameras will also have the chance to get a photo.

The Citywide Egg Hunt is free. Family ER + Urgent Care is a sponsor.
