**TASTE OF IRVING IS EXPANDING TO INCLUDE MORE MUSIC AND FOOD FOR ALL AGES  
May 19 – Free parking and admission**

**(IRVING, TEXAS)** – Bring the family and explore diverse cuisine and music genres at the Taste of Irving Music and Food Festival. Taste of Irving is returning for its fifth consecutive year. The culinary and music celebration will run from noon to 6 p.m. May 19 at Cimarron Park Recreation Center, 201 Red River Trail.

This year's event will give visitors an opportunity to sample jazz, blues, Latin and Classical music on multiple small stages throughout the event. Attendees also can see culinary stage demonstrations.
