Low-Cost Spay/Neuter and Vaccination Mobile Clinic to be at Lively Pointe Youth Center

Who: The [Spay Neuter Network](#) will provide its low-cost spay/neuter and vaccination mobile clinic for Irving residents July 12.

Where: Lively Pointe Youth Center, 909 N. O'Connor Rd.

When: Spay/Neuter check in at 8 a.m. and checkout at 3 p.m. Vaccinations will be given from 10 a.m. to noon.

Why: Irving Animal Services (IAS) hosts low-cost mobile clinics to help residents get care for their pets. For more information visit IAS [low-cost spay/neuter and pet wellness page](#).

How: Appointments are required for spay/neuter services. To make an appointment visit Spay Neuter Network's [online booking page](#) or call (972) 472-3500. Appointments are not needed for vaccinations.

More: Residents with financial restrictions can [qualify](#) to get a voucher for the free spay/neuter program by calling (972) 721-7788. Some qualifications for the free services:

- Pet must be 5 years old or younger and weigh less than 80 pounds.
- Participants need to obtain a voucher and then contact the clinic for an appointment.
- Voucher must be presented at the clinic at time of service.
