CITY OF IRVING HELPS COORDINATE DALLAS COUNTY COVID-19 TESTING SITE

(IRVING, TEXAS) — Beginning July 1, a new Dallas County COVID-19 testing site will open in the [City of Irving](#).

The site will be located at the University of Dallas, 1845 E. Northgate Dr. in Lot B. the testing is drive-thru and will take place 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Saturday.

“Having a free, six-day-a-week testing site in Irving is a tremendous benefit to our residents,” said Irving Mayor Rick Stopfer. “The University of Dallas has been so gracious to host. The location is right off of State Highway 114, near Loop 12, so the site is very easy to access.”

Dallas County and the City of Dallas are funding the site, which will replace the American Airlines testing location that closed June 30. Dallas County Health and Human Services is supervising private vendor, Honu.

The site will serve Dallas County residents who must provide address documentation and exhibit the following criteria:

- Persons with symptoms of potential COVID-19 infection, including: fever, cough, shortness of breath, chills, muscle pain, new loss of taste or smell, vomiting or diarrhea, and/or sore throat; or
- Anyone 65-years-old or older; or
- Anyone with chronic health issues (diabetes, asthma, heart issues, etc.); or
- Any first responders, DART drivers, healthcare workers, grocery store and essential retail store workers; or
- Persons without symptoms who have been actively engaged in large group settings, such as public gatherings or congregations of people.
