(IRVING, Texas) – The City of Irving published the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 (FY22) Popular Annual Financial Report (PAFR). The annual document showcases the city’s financial position, accomplishments, and activities in an easy-to-read format for those without a traditional financial background.

The document shares information on the city’s operations and work throughout the year through visually appealing charts, graphs, and infographics, that are situated among stunning scenic photographs of the city. Among the visual elements, readers also will find information on future projects and strategic plans.
