- 8:00 p.m. | Downtown Fever on the Las Colinas Stage
- 9:15 p.m. | Drone & Fireworks Show

A cooling tent with misting fans will be available. The tent also will have beer and wine for sale to visitors 21 and over. Lawn chairs and blankets are allowed. Pet owners are encouraged to leave their furry friends at home to avoid being frightened by the fireworks.
