All shows begin at 7:30 p.m.

- **Sept. 1 | E.T. (1992) PG**
 - After a gentle alien becomes stranded on Earth, he is discovered and befriended by a 10-year-old boy named Elliott.
- **Sept. 8 | Bad Guys (2022) PG**
 - After a heist goes wrong, a wily wolf and his infamous crew of animal accomplices agree to become model citizens — or at least try to.
- **Sept. 15 | Super Mario Brothers (2023) PG**
 - With help from Princess Peach, Mario gets ready to square off against the all-powerful Bowser to stop his plans from conquering the world.
- **Sept. 22 | Vivo (2021) PG**
 - Vivo, Sony Pictures Animation's first-ever musical adventure featuring all-new original songs from Lin-Manuel Miranda, will take audiences on an epic adventure to gorgeous and vibrant locations.
