The City of Irving Parks and Recreation Centers offer a smoke free environment.

The City of Irving Parks and Recreation Department thanks you for your cooperation.

Membership Information

Membership is required for each individual 12 years and older. Children 8-11 years old can come in unattended without a membership. Children 7 and younger need to be accompanied by someone 16 years or older at all times, unless the individual is in a program.

Annual IPAR Membership Fees

Resident	\$5 (proof of residency is required each year)
Corporate	\$25 (for non-residents that work in the city of Irving)
Non-Residents	\$30
Day Passes for Guests	\$5 (photo ID required)

This membership allows the participant, and their 11 and younger dependents, to sign up for classes. It also offers entry into the gymnasium and the game room at multiple recreation centers.

Registration Guidelines for Staff Programs and Classes

1. No early registration is allowed.
2. No registration is allowed by telephone, but can be done online through ActiveNet <http://activenet.active.com/IrvingRec>
Participants must have an online account and an active membership (IPAR I.D.).
3. IPAR I.D. cards must be presented and valid when registering for recreation programs.
4. Registration is on a first come first serve process. All class have limited enrollment.
5. First two days of registration are reserved for Irving residents only.
6. You may only register your immediate family members the first night of registration.

Registration limitations – online violators could lose all registrations for the session.

1. Participants cannot enroll in the same class for both Session A and Session B.
2. You may only sign up for two consecutive classes per day during a session.
3. Each person is limited to 10 classes per week for each session.

Payment is due at time of registration. Make checks payable to “City of Irving”.

Pick up any information provided for designated classes. *This schedule is subject to change. Any necessary changes will be posted at the recreation center and the parks and recreation business office no later than one week prior to registration.*
