

ARTICLE IX. - IRVING GREEN ADVISORY BOARD

Sec. 38-90. - Definitions.

For the purposes of this article:

Board means the Irving Green Advisory Board.

Sec. 38-91. - Creation; establishment.

There is hereby created and established the Irving Green Advisory Board which shall be an advisory body to the city council.

Sec. 38-92. - Purpose.

The purpose of the board is to advise the city council, to act as a contact and a voice of the residents of the City of Irving to the city council, and to review and discuss matters referred to the board by the city council, city staff, and board members on actions that concern the environment in the City of Irving. The board will provide recommendations to the city council concerning matters of sustainability and ecological significance to ensure that the City of Irving promotes environmental stewardship now and in the future.

Sec. 38-93. - Number; qualifications; and terms of office.

- (a) Number. The city council shall appoint fifteen (15) voting members.
- (b) Qualifications. All voting members of the board shall live or work within the corporate limits of the City of Irving.
- (c) Term of office. The fifteen (15) voting members shall occupy a place on the board, such places being numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, and 15, respectively. The term of office for all voting members is two (2) years. The term of office for places 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, and 15 shall expire in odd-numbered years. The term of office for places 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, and 14 shall expire in even-numbered years.

Sec. 38-94. - Duties and responsibilities.

The board shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

- (1) Make recommendations to the city council concerning matters of environmental stewardship and the responsible management of resource use;
- (2) Promote the understanding and sustainability of the City of Irving's ecology, including its natural resources and processes; and

- (3) Make recommendations regarding City of Irving plans and ordinances that may affect natural resources and processes and recommend ecologically sound policies, practices, and technologies.
