

## **David Palmer, Place 8**

David Palmer was elected to City Council by voter's city wide to Place 8 in May 2018 and is serving his second term. He was appointed Mayor Pro Tem in July 2020 and Deputy Mayor Pro Tem in June 2019. David is President and Co-Founder of PreMark Health Science, Inc., an Irving based manufacturing business with 54 employees, almost half of which make their home in Irving. Believing strongly in education, David holds a Bachelor in Business Administration, a Master's in Business Administration, and a Juris Doctor degree and is a member of the State Bar of Texas.

Palmer has an extensive history of service in the community and civic organizations. He has held leadership positions in Irving within the Boy Scouts, the PTA and the YMCA. He has been a board member of the Irving Veteran's Memorial Park Board, Tax Increment and Reinvestment Zone No. 1 Board, Planning and Zoning Commission and the Greater Irving Las Colinas Chamber of Commerce Board. David is currently a member of Irving Sister Cities.

Palmer married Allyson (a graduate of MacArthur High School) in 1983 and has lived in Irving since 1993. They are proud parents of three boys, all of who are Eagle Scouts and graduates of Irving Independent School District.

Palmer is chair to the Planning and Development Committee, co-chair to the Boards and Committees Appointments Committee and serves on the Audit and Finance Committee and the Transportation and Natural Resources Committee.
