

Kyle Taylor, District 7
May 2022 – May 2025

Councilman Kyle Taylor was re-elected to the City Council, District 7, in May 2022 and is serving his third term. He was appointed Mayor Pro Tem in June 2021 and Deputy Mayor Pro Tem in July 2020. Councilman Taylor is the CEO of Irving Cares and has worked there since 2012. He has a Bachelor of Business Administration from Northwood University.

Councilman Taylor, his wife Cydney Roberts and family have lived in District 7 since 2004. Councilman Taylor has served on a variety of community service organizations. He is currently a member of the Irving Heritage Society, the Hispanic Chamber of Commerce, and the Greater Irving-Las Colinas Chamber of Commerce.

Taylor is Chair to the Community Services Committee and Chair of the Boards and Committees Appointments. He serves on the Audit and Finance Committee and the Planning and Development Committee. He is the council liaison for the Building and Standards Commission, the Convention and Visitors Bureau Board, the Zoning Board of Adjustments, the Advisory Committee on Disabilities and the Parks and Recreation Board. Additionally, he co-chairs the Irving Police Department's Behavioral Health Leadership team.
