

**Kyle Taylor, District 7**  
May 2019 – May 2022

Councilman Kyle Taylor was re-elected to the City Council, District 7, in May 2019 and is serving his second term. He was appointed Mayor Pro Tem in June 2021 and Deputy Mayor Pro Tem in July 2020. Councilman Taylor is the CEO of Irving Cares and has worked there since 2012. He has a Bachelor of Business Administration from Northwood University.

Councilman Taylor and his wife, Cydney Roberts, have two daughters; Grace, a student at the University of Oklahoma, and Olivia, who recently graduated from high school. He and his family have lived in District 7 since 2004. Councilman Taylor has served in a variety of community organizations. He is currently on the Board of Governors for the La Cima Club, a member of the Irving Heritage Society, the Hispanic Chamber of Commerce, and the Greater Irving-Las Colinas Chamber of Commerce.

Councilman Taylor is chair of the Community Services Committee and chair of the Boards and Committees Appointments. Councilman Taylor is the council liaison for the Building and Standards Commission, the Convention and Visitors Bureau Board, the Zoning Board of Adjustments, the Advisory Committee on Disabilities and the Parks and Recreation Board.
