DISCUSSION TOPIC

1 2016 Imagine Irving Comprehensive Plan

Steve Reed, Community Development & Planning Director, presented an overview of the Comprehensive Plan and answered specific as well as general questions of the council.

Council and staff discussed the proposed residential/density plan. Some of the Council members were concerned with the suggested number of new multi-family properties; preferring more single-family homes. The density would also impact the school districts and input from the school districts was suggested. Senior housing and student housing for the various surrounding universities was also noted as a priority.

Council and staff also discussed the transportation section of the plan, noting the increase in population will impact the city's roadways significantly. Regional transportation needs were determined as a priority.

Council and staff discussed the technology and communications section; noting the importance of utilizing ICTN as the communications industry changes is a priority.

It was the consensus of the Council to move forward with the Comprehensive Plan with discussed edits, and bring the Economic Development Section back at another work session.
