



Storm Drain Marking Instructions



To help prevent dumping in storm drains, volunteers help by placing labels with a common message, “THIS DRAIN FOR RAIN, FLOWS TO CREEK” on the drains as a visual reminder that the storm drains run directly to creeks, rivers and lakes. It is an important and valuable service provided by community volunteers for the benefit of all of Irving residents. Thank you for taking the time and putting forth the effort to participate in this program.

Storm Drain Marking Kit Materials:

- 💧 Drain Markers
- 💧 Map of Storm Drains
- 💧 Safety Vests
- 💧 Latex Gloves
- 💧 Rags
- 💧 Bucket
- 💧 Liquid Adhesive (adhesive gun)
- 💧 Liability Waivers

Additional materials:

- 💧 First Aid Kit
- 💧 Drinking Water
- 💧 Snacks
- 💧 Sunscreen

Instructions for applying the drain markers:

1. Safety first and foremost. Please wear a volunteer safety vest at all times.
2. Always stay on the sidewalk and do not enter the street. Be aware of your surroundings and traffic.
3. Apply adhesive to the backside of a drain marker and place firmly to the top of curb centered to the middle of the drain inlet (see picture).
