



Storm Drain Marking Program



The City of Irving Storm Drain Marking Program is a hands-on volunteering program for those who are interested in protecting our stormwater from pollution.

To help prevent dumping in storm drains, volunteers help assist by placing labels with a common message, “THIS DRAIN FOR RAIN, FLOWS TO CREEK,” as a visual reminder that the storm drains run directly into creeks, rivers and lakes.

A volunteer team representative can pick up a drain marking kit at City Hall, 825 W. Irving Blvd., in the Capital Improvement Program Department on the 2nd floor. A volunteer waiver must be signed by the representative before receiving a kit and all volunteers in the group must sign and return forms after the drain marking is complete.

Each kit (good for 1-4 people) includes 25 storm drain markers. Upon request the kit can be customized to allow for more or fewer markers. For a group of four volunteers to place 25 markers it would take approximately 2-4 hours depending on distance and locations of storm drains and the efficiency of the volunteering group. The kit must be returned to the Capital Improvement Program once the drain marking is completed.
