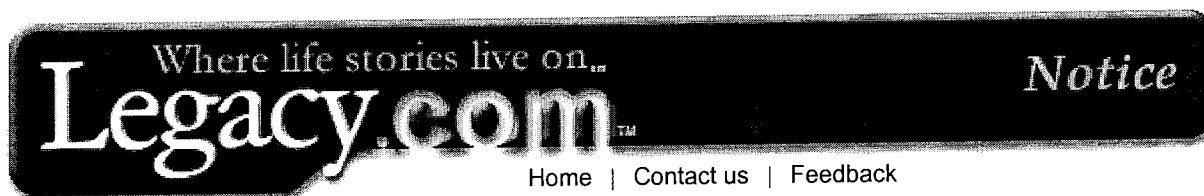
Iva N. Abraham, 86, of West Bethel, Maine, died Friday, Nov. 3, at her home.

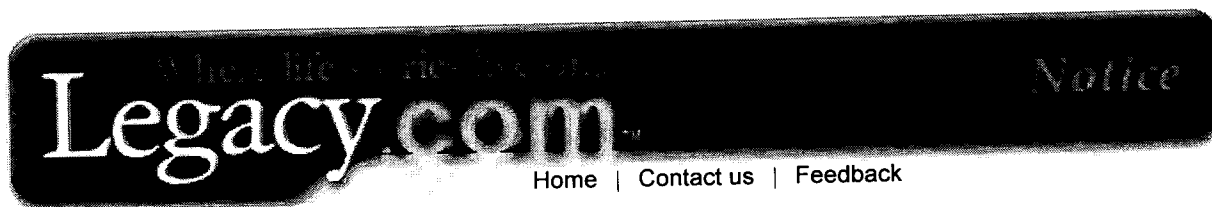

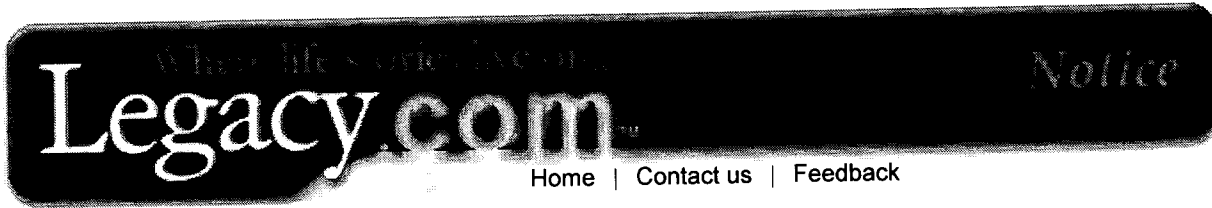

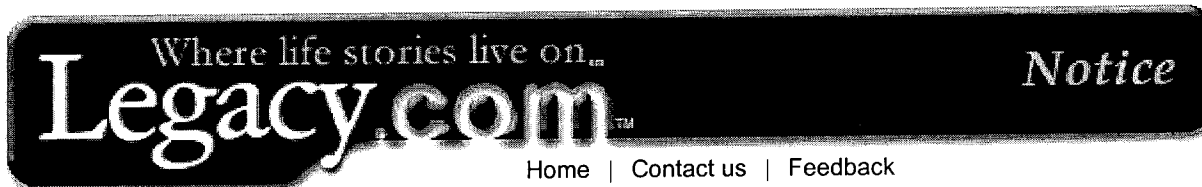
