Survivors include his parents, Marcelino Ibarra and Maria Alvarado.

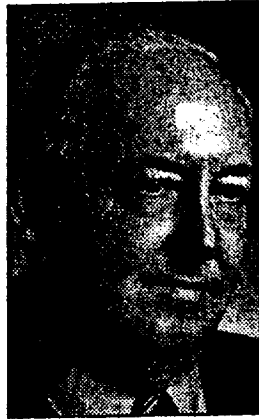
The rosary was said Thursday, Sept. 21, at Calvary Funeral Home in Irving with Reymundo Gonzales officiating. Burial was in Mexico.
