He was preceded in death by wife, Earlene Zimmerman.

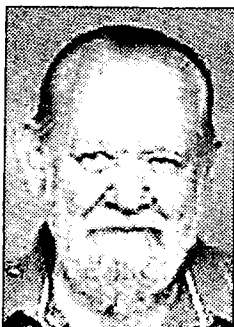
