

**CLARENCE WILLIAM (STUB)
EASTON**



Stub Easton, loving husband, father, grandfather and great grandfather passed away peacefully at Stone Brook in Denison on July

3 after a year-long illness precipitated by two broken hips.

Stub was born Aug. 20, 1918 in Adams Center, NY to Clifford and Nellie Easton. He was predeceased by his older brother Howard.

He attended Clarkson College in Potsdam, NY, graduating in 1939. He married Mary Horan of Oswego, NY in Aug. 1941. He served 3 years in the U.S. Navy and thereafter taught on the engineering faculty of Plattsburgh College (now SUNY Plattsburgh).

In 1949 he joined Ebasco Services, a leading designer and constructor of electrical power plants and built a national reputation as an expert in the start-up of power plants. Over his career he let start-up operations in scores of facilities throughout the U.S., Canada and the Caribbean.

In 1980 Stub and Mary settled in Winnsboro, TX where Stub became an active member of both the local Methodist Church and the local Country Club, eventually serving as President for both organizations. He was particularly proud of the two holes-in-one he scored after his eightieth birthday. In 2001 Stub and Mary moved to The Renaissance in Sherman to be closer to their daughters, and then to Stone Brook in Denison.

Stub is survived by Mary, his wife for almost 65 years, children Robert and wife Joan of New York City, Michael and Johnette of Sugar Land, TX, Kathleen Ingram of Durant, OK, Charles and Alicia of Houston, and Deborah and Ron Moore of Irving, plus grandchildren Rachel Easton, Jennifer Funel, Julie Goodwin, Rebecca Phillips and Kelly Whorton, plus great grandchildren Jordyn Goodwin, Connor Phillips and Haley Whorton.
