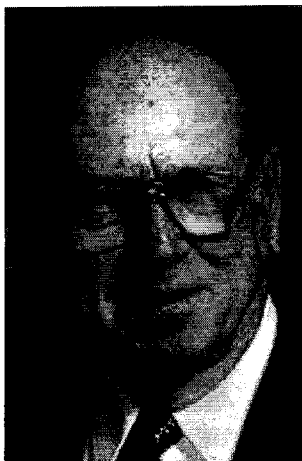

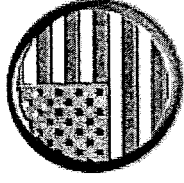

Aubry Carl Johnston Nov 24,1939 – August 15, 2013...

Carl was born in Pampa, Texas to Aubry James Johnston and Sybil Ward Johnston. He graduated from Irving High School in 1958 in the top 10 percent of his class, earning 13 sports letters and setting a national passing record by completing 46 of 64 passes against the Wichita Falls Coyotes in 1957. While he received 26 sports scholarship inquiries from colleges, Carl's dream was to attend the Air Force Academy. Although he was one of the top two candidates after taking the exam, he found that he lacked political clout, and enrolled at West Texas State where he played on the varsity football squad his freshman year.

After college, Carl learned he was a natural at sales and became District Sales manager for the Drackett Products Company in San Antonio. In 1971 he purchased Johnston Pest Control, Inc. founded by his father in 1959. He sold the company and retired with medical disability in 2001.

Among Carl's many accomplishments, he was inducted into the Irving Sports Hall of Fame, was elected the first District Governor of AMBUCS in District 6 - D, received an Award of Merit from the Boy Scouts of America Circle 10, and served as a Paul Harris Fellow in Rotary International. Carl was president of the Greater Dallas Pest Control Association, board director of the Texas Pest Control Association, and secretary of the Houston J. and Florence A. Doswell Foundation. He was also a Charter Member and Board Treasurer at Heart of Worship Baptist Church in Irving, and a member of the Irving Bible Church Small Group.

Carl loved the Lord, life, family, and his friends. He loved to fish bass and crappie in the Texas lakes with his family and friends. He loved to travel the world with his wife. He was a charmer with a mischievous smile, a sparkle in his eye, and a quick and clever wit that lifted the spirits of those around him. Those who entered his life never left it. He stayed in touch with family, friends, even friends of friends, via letters, phone, and in recent years via the Internet and text. He loved how the Internet allowed him to connect with others, to say hello or share a laugh or play dozens of simultaneous Words with Friends games. He was a kind, charismatic, generous man.
