
## City of Irving Water Utilities





- In order to transport liquid waste generated within the City of Irving, you must apply for and receive a Liquid Waste Transportation Permit from the City of Irving.
- Permits are valid for one year from the date of issue, and are non-transferable.
- Prior to a permit renewal or new permit being approved, the transporting vehicle must be inspected by Water Utilities Environmental Compliance Staff.
- ◆ To schedule a Liquid Waste Hauler Inspection, please call (972) 721-2283
  - Inspections are conducted Monday through Friday, 7:00 AM through 3:30 PM at the City of Irving Valley View Municipal Complex, located at: 333 Valley View Lane, Irving Texas 75061.
- Items that need to be provided at the time of inspection are:
  - Liquid Waste Hauler Application
  - Payment in the form of Cash or Check
    - \$150 for the first permit, \$100 for each consecutive permit
  - Copy of your TCEQ Registration Letter
  - ♦ Proof of Insurance
  - Copies of the Drivers Licenses of the Manager and all applicable Drivers
- Once you receive a liquid waste hauler permit, please keep this permit in the permitted vehicle at all times.
- All liquid waste generated within the City of Irving is required to be manifested on a
  City of Irving Liquid Waste Transportation Trip Ticket. A booklet of 10 trip tickets may
  be purchased at the 333 Valley View Lane, Irving Texas 75061 at a cost of \$10 each,
  Monday through Friday 8:00 AM through 5:00 PM.
  - Trip Tickets are required to be mailed to the City of Irving 10 business days after the date of disposal.
    - Please note that periodic field inspections of Liquid Waste Haulers are conducted to ensure compliance.
