Labor Day Weekend DWI No-Refusal Results

Irving, Texas, September 10, 2018 - The Irving Police Department conducted DWI (Driving While Intoxicated) No-Refusal operations over the Labor Day holiday weekend. The operations took place on the nights of Friday, August 31st and Saturday, September 1st by means of a grant from the Texas Department of Transportation. During No-Refusal operations, those arrested for DWI are offered only a blood test to determine their blood alcohol concentration. A search warrant, authorizing a blood draw, is sought for anyone refusing consent to a blood test.

A total of 13 DWI arrests were made by officers working grant funded positions over the holiday weekend. Additionally, officers made 2 arrests for offenses other than DWI and issued 25 traffic citations.

The Irving Police Department will continue to participate in these grant-funded operations as they have shown continued success in Irving and across the state.
