Domestic Dispute - Shooting

Irving, Texas – September 18, 2018 – The Irving Police Department continues to investigate the circumstances surrounding a domestic disturbance that occurred on Monday, September 17, 2018 in the 300 block of San Marcos Drive. At approximately 9:10 a.m. officers responded to a home on reports of a shooting and arrived to find three people who had run out of a house. Officers learned the gunman had run back into the house and that two additional victims were still inside. A perimeter was established and the SWAT team was called to the scene.

SWAT officers worked the situation as a hostage/barricaded person but attempts to make contact with the suspect were unsuccessful. During the course of the event, officers managed to rescue one victim from a backyard shed and the other from inside the house. None of the victims were seriously injured. Eventually tear gas was deployed into the house but the suspect would not come out. A search of the house found the suspect deceased from a self-inflicted gunshot wound.

The suspect is identified as 68-year-old Dzung Cong Phan of Largo, Florida. He was the ex-husband of one of the victims and had gone to the home in an effort to reconcile with her. He returned later with the intent to kill his ex-wife and her family. No photo currently available.
