



Attention Utility Customers:

On Sept. 20, 2018 the City Council enacted an amendment to Ordinance Chapter 52, titled “Water and Sewer Rates,” increasing the cost of **sewer** service effective Oct. 1, 2018 (Reflected on Statements after Nov. 1, 2018). This change affects all sewer service accounts and is as follows:

Sewer rates are based on three-month average water consumption during January through March of each year. New, single-family residential accounts are charged a maximum of \$35 until an average has been established. Customers with an average will be charged as follows:
