Description:

This file contains records of the 2004 reunion of former Irving Independent School District students who attended school in the building known as "Old Red." Old Red was a three-story red brick school built in 1913 on the district's property southeast of the intersection of Second and Jefferson Streets. Initially, it housed students of all grades. Later, the district built additional buildings for the higher grades, and Old Red was used as an elementary school until it was closed in the late 1950s. The building was demolished in 1959.

A reunion was held for all former students who attended classes in Old Red on June 10, 2006. This file contains records of that reunion, including: a brief narrative history of the building; one copy of the 2006 invitation; photocopies of the 2006 reunion's guestbook; list of invitees to the 2007 reunion with contact information; and lists of expenses.
