Mayor Gears called the meeting to order and stated that they would be canvassing the General and Special Election held on May 12, 2007.

1 Ordinance No. 8804 - Canvassing The Returns And Declaring The Results Of The General Municipal Election Held On Saturday, May 12, 2007, For The Office Of The Place One(1), Place Two (2), And Place Seven (7)

Mayor Gears introduced the item and noted that Thomas D. Spink was duly elected to Place 1, Beth Van Duyne was reelected to Place 2, and Sam Smith was reelected to Place 7.

Councilman Patrick moved to approve the ordinance as presented. Seconded by Councilman Stopfer, the motion was approved by a vote of 5-0. Councilwoman Van Duyne was not present at the time of the vote.

2 Ordinance No. 8805 – Canvassing The Return And Declaring The Results Of The Special Election Held On May 12, 2007, For The Office Of Place Five (5)

Mayor Gears introduced the item and noted that Rose Cannaday was duly elected to Place 5, a one year unexpired term.

Councilman Stopfer moved to approve the ordinance as presented. Seconded by Councilman Meagher the motion was approved by a vote of 6-0.
