The City of Irving Board of Health held its regular meeting on Monday, October 28, 2019, at 825 W. Irving Blvd, in the Third Floor Conference Room 3A located on the 3rd floor of City Hall in Irving, Texas.

Item #1 – Discussion: Preventative Health Care Outreach

Chairman Dr. Scott Schmidt began the meeting for the board discussing how to bring awareness to the community on the importance of yearly checkups. He also confirmed that the goal of the meeting was to come up with a campaign slogan that would prompt people to stay focused on Healthy Living.

Carrie Camin provided a list of possible slogans to be used to get residents in for annual checkups. The board came to an agreement of using the keywords “Got Health,” “Yearly” and “Check-up” in a slogan. After discussing, the board came up with two different slogans and stated that they would like to make one of them the official slogan for the Board of Health. The slogans were “Got Health” Find out at your yearly checkup, and “Be Happy. Be Healthy. Be Irving.”

Danielle suggested having at least two board members attend city sponsored events and having a booth set up to talk with citizens about getting health checkups. Chairman Dr. Scott Schmidt also discussed having Chamberlain University, which is an Irving base nursing school, at a health fair to provide health screenings.
