Irving, Texas - On 5/29/2020 at 09:47:41, the Irving Fire Department responded to a HazMat Incident at 6451 Riverside Dr.. The first emergency personnel were on-scene at 09:52:16. There were 5 pieces of emergency equipment sent to this scene. There were no injuries to civilians and no injuries to first responders.

Additional Comments: Call came in from Dominos Pizza, located across the street from a construction site. They reported the smell of natural gas in their store. Dispatch instructed them to evacuate the store. IFD sent Engine 11 to investigate, they deemed it a large diameter line break by the sound of spewing gas (later confirmed to be a 4" line). The line was covered with dirt and they were not able to actually see the break. The strip shopping center to the south of the break has been evacuated, and IFD declared it a HazMat Incident. Units on scene include Engine 11, 522, Battalion 2, HazMat 8, and Truck 8.
