Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES Act)
Community Development Block Grant
Public Service Funds

The City of Irving is the recipient of Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES Act) Community Development Block Grant Funds (CDBG-CV), used to address a range of Housing and Community Development activities that prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus (COVID-19). The City has received this allocation of CDBG-CV funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for use effective immediately. Eligible organizations are encouraged to apply for funding. Funds must be used to assist Irving residents and benefit low and moderate income persons/households. Applicant agencies must apply for program funding under one of the following specific categories: 1) Medical Services, 2) Meal Provision Services, or 3) Other COVID-19 Related Services. Projects and activities must also meet eligibility requirements as defined by HUD and the City of Irving's Consolidated Plan and subsequent amendments.

The City of Irving will entertain questions from organizations between **August 10, 2020 and August 14, 2020**. All responses will be provided via email to all organizations that submitted questions in a cumulative email by **August 19, 2020 at 5:00 p.m.** All questions must be submitted in writing to the City of Irving's Planning and Community Development Department (amiller@cityofirving.org). Please include your name, your organization's name and a phone number in your email, should the City need to contact you regarding clarification of your question.

Applications will be made available on or before **Monday August 3, 2020**, online at the City of Irving's website (<https://www.cityofirving.org/562/CDBG-ESG-HOME-grant-applications>). A person or organization without internet access may obtain a copy of the funding application packet by contacting the Planning and Community Development Department at 972-721-4800. The application deadline is **5:00 p.m., Friday, August 21, 2020**. **No late application submissions will be accepted.**

Application proposals will be reviewed by the Housing and Human Services Board and/or appointed sub-committee(s) before being submitted to City Council for approval in **October 2020**.
