## INFORMATION RELEASE

### Officer Involved Shooting Case# 20-13173

UPDATE: July 6, 2020 – The suspect has been identified as 59 year-old Rogelio Castro. The preliminary investigation indicates that Castro died from a self-inflicted gunshot wound to the head. The victim has been released from the hospital.

Irving, Texas, July 4, 2020 – The Irving Police Department is investigating an officer involved shooting that occurred on July 4, 2020 at approximately 10:00 a. m. in the 800 block of Elwood Rd. Officers responded to an unknown call for police where the victim reported that she had been shot by the suspect, her husband.

Suspect fled the location before police arrived. Officers canvassed the area and found the suspect in the backyard of a neighboring property. When officers entered the backyard, they announced themselves, the suspect and officers both discharged their weapons. The suspect was pronounced deceased at the scene. The victim was transported to a local hospital with non-life threatening injuries. No officers were injured.
