Officer Involved Shooting Case #20-13248

UPDATE: July 6, 2020 – The suspect in this incident, 41 year-old Johnny Drumgole, has been arrested and booked into the Irving City Jail for aggravated assault against a public servant with a \$500,000 bond, and auto theft with a \$50,000 bond. Drumgole's injuries consisted of minor scrapes. The officer suffered injury to his legs from being pinned between the driver's side door of the stolen vehicle and his patrol vehicle. The officer is at home recovering.



Irving, Texas, July 5, 2020 – The Irving Police Department is investigating an officer involved shooting that occurred on July 5, 2020 at 1:10 p. m. at 3200 W. Irving Blvd (Home Depot). Officers responded to a stolen vehicle call. The reporting party had found their stolen vehicle and called Irving Police.

First officer on scene observed a male suspect walking up to the stolen vehicle, attempted to detain him, and the suspect actively resisted by pulling away from the officer. The suspect got into the stolen vehicle and put the vehicle in drive, causing the officer to be wedged between two vehicles and attempted to seriously injure or kill the officer to get away. The officer fearing for his life discharged his duty weapon. The suspect was not shot, stopped resisting arrest and was taken into custody. Both the officer and suspect were taken to the hospital with non-life threatening injuries. The suspect faces numerous charges upon his release to include aggravated assault on a public servant.
