John C. Danish was re-elected to Irving City Council, District 1, in May 2019 and is serving his third term. He was appointed Deputy Mayor Pro Tem in 2017 and Mayor Pro Tem in 2018. Councilman Danish is an attorney and Counselor at Law and has practice law in his Irving office since 1975. He was previously elected to Irving City Council in 1987 and served until 1992.

For more than 25 years he has been an active member in the Irving community serving on multiple boards and volunteering his time and expertise to various organizations. Councilman Danish has been the City of Irving representative on the DART Board of Directors since 2005 and was the Chairman of the Board from 2011 to 2013. He has served on the Planning and Zoning Commission, was the founder and chairman of the Irving South Economic Resources Values and Economics Committee (ISERVE), a prior member of the Citizen Advisory Council for DART, a member of Rotary International and a founding director and current chairman of the Irving Veterans Memorial Park Board of Trustees. Councilman Danish has also serviced the American Heart Association Board of Directors, the Heritage Society, and the New Tomorrows Shelter. Councilman Danish is married to Debra Danish and has a daughter, Karis.

Councilman Danish serves on the Community Services Committee and the Planning and Development.
