

# Getting started with


Hoopla is a revolutionary digital service, offering hundreds of thousands of movies, full music albums, audiobooks, eBooks, comics and more. It's simple to access and use - all you need is your library card and a web browser, smart phone or tablet!

## Kindle Fire HD Tablets

This instruction set applies to Kindle Fire HD (7<sup>th</sup> generation+) tablets. Devices running Fire OS 6.0.0 and newer are supported.

1. Download the Hoopla Digital app from the Amazon App store.
2. Open the Hoopla app and **Login** with your **Email** and **Password**.
  - Tap **Sign Up** (under the Login button) if you don't already have an account. Select or search for Irving Public Library.
  - Follow the prompts to create a Hoopla account: enter your Irving Public Library card number and your PIN, enter an email address, a password. Read the Terms and Conditions and then tap **Sign Me Up** to create your account.
3. Each account can download 7 items of any format each calendar month. The number of items you can borrow for the current month displays on the home page.
4. To find available titles, you can:
  - Browse the titles on the home page
  - Run a search (tap the magnifying glass), entering an author, title, subject or keyword
5. To check out a title, tap the cover image, then tap **BORROW**. That title will be added to your **Borrowed** page.
6. For movies, music and audiobooks, a **Play** option will appear. For eBooks and comics a **READ** option will appear. Tapping these will begin playback or open the title.
7. Movies are available for 3 days, music albums are available for 7 days and all other items are available for 21 days.

### TIPS

- Titles are streamed to the device. To download a title for offline access, tap on the **Tap here to Download** button below the blue **Play** button on the title details screen.
- You can return the title before the lending period has expired by tapping **Return Now** link located at the bottom of the title information page. **Please note that returning a title early does not give users additional borrows for that month.** Downloaded items are deleted automatically on the due date.
- All items are always available, so holds are not necessary. Titles can be added to a *Favorites* list for future borrowing by tapping the **Favorite**  icon on the title information page.
- You may get requests from Hoopla for certain app permissions, we recommend that you allow these to ensure that you are getting Hoopla's full functionality.
