

ORDINANCE NO. ORD-2022-10583

AN ORDINANCE CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON MAY 7, 2022; FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING CITY COUNCIL PLACES ONE (1), TWO (2) AND SEVEN (7); PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

WHEREAS, on January 27, 2022, the Irving City Council, by Ordinance No. ORD-2022-10546, called a Regular Municipal Election to be held on Saturday, May 7, 2022 for the purpose of electing City Council Places One (1), Two (2) and Seven (7); and

WHEREAS, on March 10, 2022, the Irving City Council, by Ordinance No. ORD-2022-10561 accepted the certification that Brad M. LaMorgese, candidate for City Council Place 2 was unopposed in the May 7, 2022 Regular Municipal Election and declared Brad M. LaMorgese elected to office for Place 2 for said election; and

WHEREAS, public notice of the Regular Municipal Election was duly given, and such election was duly and properly held and administered in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas, the Charter of the City of Irving, and the Federal Voting Rights Act of 1965; and

WHEREAS, a canvass of the Regular Municipal Election returns was conducted on May 17, 2022; and

WHEREAS, it was found that the persons herein named received the following votes for said term of office on the Irving City Council of the City of Irving, Texas:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IRVING, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Regular Municipal Election held on May 7, 2022 was duly and legally called and notice thereof given in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas, the Charter of the City of Irving, and the Federal Voting Rights Act of 1965 and the ordinances calling said election; that said election was held in strict conformity with the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas, the Charter of the City of Irving, and the Federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, and the returns thereof have

been properly made to the officials of the City of Irving entitled to receive the same, and that said election properly represents the desires of the voters of the City of Irving.

SECTION 2. That the following named candidates were duly elected at said Regular Municipal Election to the respective named offices of the City of Irving:

Brad M. LaMorgese – Council Member Place 2, At-Large

Kyle Taylor – Council Member Place 7, District 7 – Single Member

SECTION 3. That a runoff election will be held on June 18, 2022, between Tony Grimes and John Bloch to determine who will be elected as Council Member Place 1, District 1 – Single Member.

SECTION 4. It is hereby declared that the City of Irving approves and accepts the results of the Regular Municipal Election, as set forth in the Election Returns Sheet attached herein as “Exhibit A.”


SECTION 5. Should any court of competent jurisdiction declare any section, subsection, clause, or phrase of this ordinance unconstitutional or invalid, it is expressly provided that any and all remaining portions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance, and each section, subsection, clause and phrase, without the inclusion of any unconstitutional or invalid provisions.

SECTION 6. It is officially found, determined, and declared that the meeting at which this ordinance is adopted was open to the public and public notice of the time, place, and subject matter of the public business to be considered at such meeting was given.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the United States of America.


SECTION 8. This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage.
