

ORDINANCE NO. ORD-2022-10602

AN ORDINANCE CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE RUNOFF ELECTION HELD ON JUNE 18, 2022, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING THE COUNCIL MEMBER FOR IRVING CITY COUNCIL, PLACE 1, FOR A TERM OF THREE (3) YEARS; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

WHEREAS, the City of Irving, Texas, held a Runoff Election on June 18, 2022, for the purpose of electing a Council Member to Place 1 for a term of three (3) years; and

WHEREAS, public notice of the Runoff Election was duly given, and such election was duly and properly held and administered in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas, the Charter of the City of Irving, and the Federal Voting Rights Act of 1965; and

WHEREAS, a canvass of the Runoff Election returns was conducted on June 29, 2022; and

WHEREAS, it was found that the persons herein named received the following votes for said term of office on the Irving City Council of the City of Irving, Texas:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IRVING, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Runoff Election held on June 18, 2022, was duly and legally called and notice thereof given in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas, the Charter of the City of Irving, the Federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, and the ordinances calling and amending said election; that said election was held in strict conformity with the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas, the Charter of the City of Irving, and the Federal Voting Rights Act of 1965; that the returns thereof have been properly made to the officials of the City of Irving entitled to receive the same; and that said election properly represents the desires of the voters of the City of Irving.

SECTION 2. That the following named candidate was duly elected at said Runoff Election to the respective named office of the City of Irving:

John Bloch – Council Member Place 1, District 1 – Single Member

SECTION 3. It is hereby declared that the City of Irving approves and accepts the results of the Runoff Election for Council Member Place 1, as set forth in the Election Returns Sheet attached herein as “Exhibit A.”


SECTION 4. Should any court of competent jurisdiction declare any section, subsection, clause, or phrase of this ordinance unconstitutional or invalid, it is expressly provided that any and all remaining portions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance, and each section, subsection, clause and phrase, without the inclusion of any unconstitutional or invalid provisions.

SECTION 5. It is officially found, determined, and declared that the meeting at which this ordinance is adopted was open to the public and public notice of the time, place, and subject matter of the public business to be considered at such meeting was given.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the United States of America.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage.
