Councilman LaMorgese was elected to the Irving City Council, District 6, in May of 2012 and re-elected in May of 2015. He served as Deputy Mayor Pro Tem in 2015 and Mayor Pro Tem in 2016. Councilman LaMorgese was elected to the Irving City Council in Place 2 (Citywide) in May of 2022.

While on the City Council, Councilman LaMorgese has served as chair for the Transportation and Natural Resources Committee, the Planning and Development Committee and led the Boards and Committees Appointments. Additionally, he previously served on the Audit and Finance Committee and the Public Safety Committee.

Councilman LaMorgese serves as the Council Liaison to the Regional Transportation Council, and has also previously served on the Irving Flood Control District - Section III, the North Central Texas Council of Government, the Trinity River Authority and the Upper Trinity Regional Water District.

Councilman LaMorgese is Board Certified in Family Law and one of the few appellate family lawyers in Texas. He has had success in dozens of cases in Texas Appeals Courts, Texas Supreme Court and the U.S. 5th Circuit Court of Appeals.
