PLEA / DEFERRED DISPOSITION AFFIDAVIT

I, the undersigned defendant, do hereby waive the filing and reading of a sworn complaint, waive my right to trial (jury and/or non-jury), and enter my plea of nolo contendere (no contest) to the above numbered case and request that I be granted deferred disposition. I understand by entering a plea of guilty/nolo contendere (no contest), I agree to pay the court-ordered fines, court costs, and/or fees and a failure to so do may result in the issuance of a warrant for my arrest.

I do also swear, or affirm, that I have not had deferred disposition within the last year in the City of Irving, and I did not have a Commercial Driver's License ON THE DATE AND TIME OF THE ALLEGED OFFENSE, NOR DO I HAVE ONE NOW. I also understand that if the citation was issued on, or after September 1, 2005 for a moving traffic violation, completion of a six hour Driving Safety Course IS REQUIRED IF I WAS UNDER 25 YEARS OF AGE ON THE DATE OF THE OFFENSE.

The defendant's plea of nolo contendere has been accepted. The Court finds the defendant guilty and orders the defendant to pay an administrative fee of: call the Court at 972-721-2451 for amount. THE ADMINISTRATIVE FEE AND THIS AFFIDAVIT MUST BE RETURNED TO THE COURT no later than 21 calendar days from the date your citation was issued. NO PARTIAL PAYMENTS OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE FEE WILL BE ACCEPTED BY THE COURT.

Upon approval by the Judge, the deferral period of 90 days will begin on the date payment is received by the Court. If the administrative fee and court costs are not received by the due date, this plea will be accepted for a conviction and (in accordance with State law) an additional \$25 per violation will be assessed 31 days after judgment is entered on the case.

The defendant MUST NOT BE CONVICTED of any other similar violations of the law, which occur during the deferment period. Additionally, if a Driving Safety Course has been required, I MUST RETURN MY COMPLETION CERTIFICATE TO THE COURT PRIOR TO THE END OF THE DEFERRAL PERIOD.

IF THE ABOVE CONDITIONS ARE NOT MET, THE JUDGMENT OF GUILTY WILL BECOME FINAL, THE ADMINISTRATIVE FEE WILL BE USED FOR PAYMENT OF FINE, AND THE CONVICTION WILL BE REPORTED TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY.
