Description

The file contains two black-and-white photographs. One of the photos is a 2" x 2½" black-and-white photo of E. J. (Jack Johnson) in front of his feed store, c. 1940s. Jack Johnson was the mayor of Irving during the 1940s. The second photo is an Irving School class photo. The class level and date of the photo are unknown. It appears to be about a sixth or seventh grade class during the mid-1940s. Also included in the collection is a digital image of the "Programme of Graduation, Irving High School, Class of 1949."

The photos have been removed and placed in MVF Photo Collection Box #1. A photocopy of the photos is in this file and a printed copy of the graduation program is also in the file.
